GUIDANCE TO STUDENTS ASPIRING TO PARTICIPATE IN AAVISHKAR- A RESEARCH PROJECT COMPETITION.

Aavishkar is a research festival which provides platform for all students to present and globalize their innovations, ideas and skills. KBCNM University, Jalgaon has taken special efforts to encourage the students from rural and urban areas of Khandesh for active participation in Aavishkar. In our college, Science Association conducted guidance to students aspiring to participate in Aavishkar. This activity is specially designed for advanced learners, aimed to foster creativity, critical thinking, and research skills among them. We hoped to encourage students to delve into various topics of interest, conduct research, and present their findings through posters or models through this activity.

Total 14 students and teachers were participated in this activity conducted on 18th October to 20th October 2022. Advanced learners were provided with guidance on how to conduct research effectively. This included techniques for literature review, data collection through experiments, surveys or other means, analyze their findings, and draw conclusions. Students were encouraged to explore diverse topics across various disciplines. Students were prompted to generate ideas for their research projects based on their interests, curiosities, and real-world issues. They were encouraged to think critically and creatively to identify research questions worth exploring. They were also guided to design visually appealing posters or models that effectively communicate their research process and outcomes.

Outcomes of the Activity:

Through this Guidance to students aspiring to participate in Aavishkar activity students developed their research skills, including problem-solving, critical thinking and data analysis. They learned to approach complex issues systematically and creatively. Students improved their communication skills by presenting their research findings in poster or model form. They learned to convey complex ideas concisely and clearly to their peers and teachers. Presenting research findings in a public forum boosted students' confidence and self-esteem. They gained valuable experience in articulating their ideas, defending their conclusions.
