Report of the Programme:

On the occasion of Constitution Day, ICC in collaboration with NSS and Taluka Legal Services Organization, Chalisgaon organized one day workshop on Women empowerment.

The Hon. Guests along with Hon. Principal inaugurated the workshop by garlanding the images of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar and Constitution of India. Dr. R. P. Nikam conducted the program. Hon. Judge Adv. Valke, read the Preamble of Constitution of India all present in the gathering repeated it after him and gave 'Preamble Pledge' to all.

Hon, Judge Adv. Valke, a legal expert conducted an enlightening seminar focusing on the critical issue of women's safety. The seminar aimed to raise awareness about the challenges women face regarding safety and to explore legal avenues and preventive measures to address these concerns effectively. Adv. Valke began by providing an overview of the various threats to women's safety, including physical violence, sexual harassment, domestic abuse, and gender-based discrimination.

He further explained the legal framework governing women's safety, including relevant legislation and constitutional provisions. He elucidated the rights guaranteed to women under the law and discussed mechanisms for seeking legal recourse in cases of violence or harassment. He also addressed the role of law enforcement agencies and the judiciary in ensuring justice for victims.

Next seminar was by Mr. Takale, an expert in Cyber security. He delivered a comprehensive seminar on the rising issue of Cybercrime against women.
